Household waste recycling centres

There are currently two centres in the Borough located at Pindar Road, Hoddesdon and Brookfield Farm, Fairways, Cheshunt. The centres accept a wide range of materials for recycling, and are for household waste only, including:

- Metals
- Wood
- Fridges and other appliances
- TVs and computers
- Tyres and batteries
