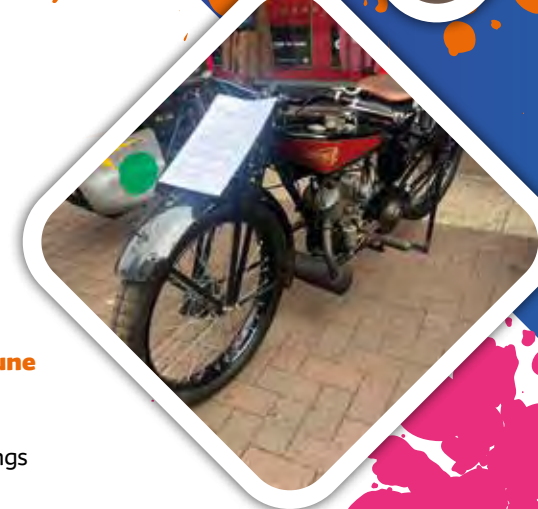

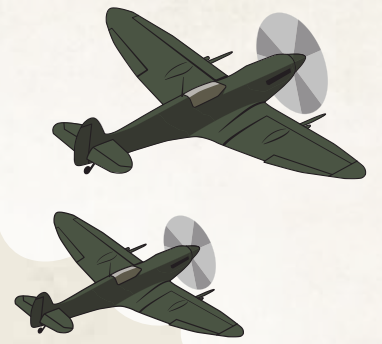
Heritage Trails

A number of trails have been produced to help residents and visitors to the Borough discover more of Broxbourne's fascinating history.

Two new treasure trail maps, one for Hoddesdon and one for Cheshunt, have been created by Treasure Map Trails on behalf of the Council. The animated maps, take families on an adventure around the town centres to hunt for hidden treasures. The two maps feature different themes, with Hoddesdon's illustrating an animated town centre invaded by 'fantastical animals', and the Cheshunt Map depicting an invasion by 'dragons' seemingly settling into familiar modern-day activities. The maps also contain a wealth of historical information and fun facts about the town centres which will leave all explorers with greater knowledge about the local areas.



All three trails can be collected from local libraries or from Lowewood Museum.



An additional trail was produced to mark the 80th anniversary of the end of World War Two, and shows key sites in the Borough including Lieutenant Ellis Way where an American bomber crashed in August 1944, the role of Broxbourne Aerodrome, locations where bombs fell including Chadwick and Shapcott's Acorn Works in Waltham Cross where a V2 bomb hit in January 1945, Burnt Farm Camp which hosted an anti-aircraft gunsite, the sites of Broxbourne's four war memorials, locations of pillboxes which were built to defend London, and roads that have been named after the Borough's wartime history.
