

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH STOPPING UP ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257

BROXBOURNE BOROUGH COUNCIL

Broxbourne Borough Council (Cheshunt 16) Stopping Up Order 2020

The above order was made on 6th August 2020. The effect of this order will be to:

1. Stop up the full width of Cheshunt Footpath 16 commencing at junction with Cheshunt Footpath 13 at TL 3482 0115 (Point A on the Order Plan) running in a generally easterly direction for approximately 165 metres to a junction with Cheshunt Bridleway 75 (Theobalds Lane) at TL 3498 0113 (Point A on the Order Plan).
2. Create an alternative footpath commencing at junction with Cheshunt Bridleway 75 (Theobalds Lane) at TL 3501 0114 (Point C on the Order Plan) and running generally north north west, parallel to the access road, for approximately 50 metres to TL 3498 0119 (Point D on the Order Plan). Then continuing generally north east, parallel to the access road, for approximately 75 metres to track running generally east/west at TL 3502 1205 (Point E on the Order Plan). Then continuing generally west along the permissive path for approximately 185 metres to the eastern bank of the New River and a junction with Cheshunt Footpath 16 at TL 3483 0126 (Point E on the Order Plan). Width 5 metres.

If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
