## THE BOROUGH OF BROXBOURNE COUNCIL (BOROUGH OFFICES BISHOPS' COLLEGE CAR PARK SOUTH)(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2021

The Borough of Broxbourne Council ("the Council"), pursuant to arrangements made under Section 9EA of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Authorities (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2012, in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and with the consent of the Hertfordshire County Council hereby proposes the following

- This Order may be cited as The Borough of Broxbourne Council (Borough Offices Bishops`
  College Car Park South)(Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 2021 (hereafter
  referred to as "this Order" and shall come into operation on DDMMYYYY.
- 2. This Order shall amend:

The Borough of Broxbourne (Borough Offices Bishops' College Car Park South)(Off-Street Parking Places Order) 2019

3. "The Borough of Broxbourne (Borough Offices Bishops' College Car Park South)(Off-Street Parking Places Order) 2019" shall be amended as follows:

After the paragraph in Article 4 for the definition "Virtual Permit" insert:

"Electric Vehicle"- unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle designed and constructed to be propelled by electricity, supplied by a battery or other form of electrical cell or reservoir, or a plug-in hybrid electric vehicle

"Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Space" – means a part of a Parking Place which has been marked as intended for the exclusive use of an electric vehicle whilst said vehicle is being charged and at which is provided an electric vehicle charging point and is appropriately signed

"Electric Vehicle Charging Point" – means a purpose-built unit designed specifically for charging electric vehicles

After Article 28, insert the following Articles:

29. Except as provided in Article 30, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer or Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle other than an electric vehicle to wait in the Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Space, when the vehicle is connected to the Electric Vehicle Charging Point.

- 30. Nothing in Article 29 of this Order shall:
- (a) prohibit any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait or load in any of Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Space:
  - (i) for as long as may be necessary to enable the electric vehicle to be charged by the electric vehicle charging point;
  - (ii) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any parking place referred to, or the laying erection, alternation or repair in or near to any of the said parking place, or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus, as defined in the Telecommunications Act, 1984
  - (iii) to enable the vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes;
  - (iv) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his/her control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (b) apply to an emergency service vehicle.
