# 07/18/0514/F - Cheshunt Sports Village - Representations in Support

As you are aware, we are instructed by the applicants in relation to the above application. Enclosed with this letter are copies of a substantial number of representations (including letters and e-mails from local residents in support and a petition). These documents are not new and have previously been submitted to the Council in support of the planning application relating to Cheshunt Sports Village.

We present them here again because of the delay in determining the application. These representations continue to represent a significant material consideration in support of the proposals. The applicants wish is to reiterate the weight of support for the application. We would request that this support and the reasons for support are referenced in the Officer's addendum report and verbally communicated to members at committee.

In particular, it is relevant that there are a total of 121 letters and emails of support along with a petition with 413 signatories.

Given the strength of this support, it is important that Members are aware of this strength of this material consideration. It is the applicants' submission that this strong support stems from Cheshunt Football Club's strong roots in the community. Importantly the wide-ranging support has come from across the community, including support from local residents (including Montayne Road), local sports clubs, local community groups, local schools such as St. Mary's School, local businesses, and governing bodies such as the Herts FA and Herts Chamber of Commerce.

A summary of the supporting comments is set out here. There is a clear picture that in the eyes of the local residents the proposals constitute:

 An imaginative, vibrant and attractive scheme that meets many local objectives including providing sports and community facilities, housing and employment;

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- Will provide new sports and community facilities to help address existing deficits and meet the anticipated growth in the population over the next 10-15 years.
- Will create a community-sporting hub, accessible for local clubs, schools and community groups for education, training and competition.
- Safeguard the future of Cheshunt Football Club through new improved facilities, sustainable income and larger supporter base.
- Support the Club in growing its range of teams and award winning community and education programmes.
- Provide a range of much needed family homes to meet the housing need within the Borough.
- Attract local businesses, encourage an entrepreneurial culture and to stimulate the local economy through inward investment, job creation and increased secondary spend.
- Encourage more people to maintain a healthy lifestyle, to combat the high levels of obesity in the borough and improve the social and economic wellbeing of the local community.
- Enrich the sporting provision for the local area that would only serve to benefit young people
  in the local community now and for future generations.
- Contribute to a reduction in anti-social behaviours and the positive improvement of health and life chances for our local community.
- Sustainable location which means the local community, and in particular young people, can be independent in their travel to the scheme using public transport links
- Regenerate an underutilised, previously developed site of low ecological value.
- Have a positive impact on sport, recreation, health and living standards in and around the local area.
- Enhance Broxbourne as a place to help improve richness of life, wellbeing and achievement.
- Be the starting point and catalyst for further investment in and around Waltham Cross

May I take a moment of your day to register my support for the proposed development at Cheshunt FC. I have been a resident in the area for eighteen years, living in Northfield Road EN8, a ten minute walk from Cheshunt FC.

I have studied the proposal, Dean Williamson's ideas and vision. This is the most joined up, and well thought out proposal of building work I have seen in years, and I look forward to seeing it take shape.

From a community perspective, in my opinion the Waltham Cross area will really benefit from there being a hub, where multiple activities are available on a sporting theme, the proposal attracts local businesses to be part of the regeneration, has the potential to create local jobs for local people and provides a community focussed approach not competing directly with the Laura Trott Centre or the White Water Centre but potentially complementing & adding to the facilities the area can claim. Local people can spend local money with local business, how often do we find ourselves spending our recreational cash in someone else's borough?

My son progressed through the youth teams at Cheshunt, and both he & I volunteer at the club, to show our support not only of our local team, but the forward thinking Cheshunt Sports & Leisure have bought to the area. I can remember when Cheshunt FC were the poor relation compared with Enfield, Ware, Harlow, Potters Bar and they weren't shy in telling us so. Those clubs now see Cheshunt FC as a peer, and are wary of the future potential.

The facilities were a struggle, and the community spirit pulled the club through some dark times, I am convinced that same community will be proud of new development & make full use of it. The time, sacrifice & financial investment to date of Cheshunt Sports & Leisure, and the professional approach now being applied by its Directors, is putting the area on the map, and attracting welcome attention to the club & area. To see film crews using the facilities that exist today, local kids watching AC Fiorentina train, their heroes the F2 Freestylers filming, and the hire facilities being fully booked are such wonderful successes for local people to share, and the proposal provides so much more opportunity for the area.

Of course, a development of this nature is big business & I for one was initially sceptical of new ownership, however I can truly claim to be fully supportive of this proposal, because I have seen the development of Cheshunt FC over the last five years and been fortunate enough to be both involved and benefit from the progress. Everything the Chairman stated he wanted to happen has been delivered, and delivered on time. It has been worked in conjunction with the local community,

many of whom I have worked alongside to realise the improvements we see today. None of this would have happened without the vision & commitment of Cheshunt Sports & Leisure. As a parent who has managed a child with autism to adult hood and with a wife who works with special needs children in the borough, it is so refreshing to see the social acceptance and integration of the adults with these challenges into the sporting community. The proposal to develop into Cheshunt Sports Village can only provide further opportunity for all of our local communities to integrate further.

I have considered 3 areas personally important to me when reviewing these proposals, I recognise the need for housing in the borough, and I recognise the need for local long term work opportunities,

For me, the Cheshunt Sports Village proposals meet all of my personal criteria

Dear Peter, I am writing in support of the development of Cheshunt Sports Village. I have read through the application several times and believe it would be a valuable resource of sports facilities, small business opportunities and housing which is always needed in an ever growing population.

I am senior manager of 4 residential homes for young adults with learning disabilities, Autism and associated mental heath, I struggled for years to find sporting opportunities for our clients. Cheshunt FC was a door we knocked on 10 years ago. They kindly allowed us to practise football, general fitness on their grass pitches. As time has progressed we now have 3 teams in the Herts disability league. One Special Olympic team and 2 pan disability teams. The support that we received and more importantly the welcome we received has been a real positive for our clients and their friends. During this period we have also become close followers of the Cheshunt team, attending their matches every week and travelling by car or in the coach to away games. I lived in Ponders End in 60s/70s, visited my cousins in Cheshunt most weekends to go to Cheshunt Park and Grundy Park. I eventually moved to Cheshunt. During that time I always felt that Cheshunt needed more sports facilities as I travelled to Wodson Park, John Warner and Frederick knight in Yottenham. The opening of the 3G at Cheshunt has already changed our ability to offer training facilities for our teams. (We train Thursday and Sundays).

What is apparent is the commitment both from Dean, the volunteers and staff that are Cheshunt FC. We are proud to be a small part of Cheshunt FC. The proposed development will give sports, housing and business opportunities for Cheshunt residents and in time a venue for Cheshunt to be proud of. I always hoped that one day there will be a river of yellow scarfs and hats walking towards Cheshunt FC to support their local team. requested 3/7/18ENA 505

# Dear Peter,

I'm just writing a quick e-mail to support Dean Williamson and his plans at Cheshunt FC. Being from the area having grown up in Cheshunt and now a Primary school teacher/PE specialist at both Dewhurst St Marys and Holy Trinity (Just down the road from Cheshunt FC), and also being the treasurer for the local school sports association the WDPSSA. I feel that I am in a unique position to express my support and excitement at what Dean is proposing.

I have had the pleasure of experiencing the excellent facilities at Cheshunt, as we have held several football tournaments through the WDPSSA at Cheshunt FC over the past couple of years. We are now planning to hold all of our tournaments there and looking at organising league games and even group training sessions. We have never had any problems and all the parents and supporters have only ever had great things to say about the venue. As far as booking and organising the tournaments, things couldn't be more professional and easy. Holy Trinity even have there own weekend club that now also use the facilities at Cheshunt. There is also a huge youth section that seems to be growing at Cheshunt and a development like this will only help it to grow and encourage other clubs to do the same.

These plans could really help Cheshunt, as there is no real sporting hub for the local community to get behind. There is a lot of great young talent in Cheshunt and a venue like this could really help to inspire young children into participating, taking up or just becoming involved in sport. 



I cannot thank the club enough for the welcome and help provided to all of our players and officials since the teams inception, they truly are a part of the community and bend over backwards to help in any way possible.



I am writing to give my support to the planning application 07/16/1369/F for the proposed development at Cheshunt Stadium. Theobalds Lane. Cheshunt - known as 'Cheshunt Sporting Village' - for the following reasons...

### 1. IMPROVING THE LOCALITY

As a home-owner on Dodley Avenue, only 400 yards from Cheshunt Footbal. Club, any proposals for changes at the site are of great concern to me. I was active amongst fellow residents in opposing proposed plans by Enfield Football. Club to take over and build on the site in 1999 as I believed then -and still do - that those plans would have drastically altered the Thechalds locality for the worse, bringing traffic and disruption into the area for no obvious benefit to those of us who lived adjacent to the ground.

These plans are very different. Not only are they providing much needed new facilities for local residents to use and enjoy, they will be provided at no cost to the ratepayer and, of great importance to local home-owners like myself, all the housing being proposed in this scheme are to be privately owned to compliment the existing privately owned housing in the area.

I would say the single biggest concern amongst local residents is that, for want of a better word, a 'council estate' will appear on their doorsteps, massively changing the area almost certainly for the worst and ultimately devaluing their properties.

The beauty of this scheme is that instead of a percentage of the proposed houses being 'affordable', the net benefit to the locality will not be in the form of cheap housing but in community sports, health and community facilities for all to use.

All over Broxbourne small developments of houses and flats are going up, all with a number of affordable housing included yet with no benefits for existing local people to use, such as Doctors surgery's, children's nuseries and youth clubs ever seamingly being included in these schemes Time after time, new flats are built with their new occupants adding to the numbers using already overloaded local facilities. So I am delighted to see that here we will have a development that will actually give the people of Theobalds something back in return.

### 2. A DEVELOPER WITH A PERSONAL INTEREST IN THE CLUB

After decades of decay and abuse, the Williamson family took over the running of Cheshunt football Club in 2010. And in those seven years we have seen...

- A. The fencing for the entire 24 acre site totally replaced. Before this the site was used as a hang out for local gangs, attracting noise, drinking, vanda ism and pretty crime to the area. Also parents of youth team players would frequently ignore the clubs car parks, park in Albury Walk and Albury Ride and just walk through the gaps in the old fencing, causing much congestion and annoyance to residents on those streets. All of this has now stopped.
- B. The building of state-of the-art artificial football pitches on the site for the local community to enjoy. To my knowledge, these pitches are well used by local sides not just Cheshunt Football Clubs own youth teams and at no expense or risk to local ratepayers.
- C. The ground itself, with no significant investment since the early 1970's, has been given a total revamp in the last few years. New floodlighting (which doesn't pollute the sky with tight anywhere near as much as the old 60's era floodlights they replaced), pitch perimeter fence, specialor walkways, terrace covers and a new 200 seat stand, have all been installed in the last two years. From the supporters of the club, local people who have endured dreadful speciator facilities for decades, this has been very well received.
- D. The two clubhouses on the site have not only been totally rebuilt internally but now a whole host of new organisations make use of them (weight-watchers for example). No previous owners have been so welcoming or have hosted such a diverse range of community organisations through its doors.

The proposed plans show these new community uses for the ground not only continuing but expanding too in bigger and belief surroundings. With the loss of the nearby Cheshurit Comrades of the Great War Club and now Wolsey half, the need for indoor community space is greater than ever.

The owners have also stated that they are happy to see the council ensure a percentage of the housing sales be ringfericed for the proposed community facilities to reassure residents that they will definitely be built.

I believe the owners of the club, by their actions so far, have shown they can deliver genuine improvements to the areas surroundings and to community facilities so should be allowed to continue this with their proposed Cheshunt Village plan.

### 3. MODEST SCALE

Looking at the Cheshurt Village plans, I see quite a small scale development. This is a 24 acre site yet only 158 houses and flats are being proposed. Any other development would be looking at many more homes on a site this large but instead the majority of the site is being used for football pitches, its associated car parking and the stadium itself. And looking at the houses and flats, none overlook existing homes due to the angles they are being built at and by the large amount of greenery being planted to shield them from their neighbours.

Much has been said by the owners long-term intent on to have a 5,000 at seat capacity stadium on the site but how many people realise....

- a. That the current capacity is already 2,500?
- b. That Cheshunt Football Clubs average average attendance is under 200?
- c. That Cheshunt Footba I Clubs average attendance has been under 200 since the mid 1960's?
- d. That the last time Cheshunt recorded a home attendance of over 1,000 was in 1968? (an Amateur Cup tid v Enfield allendance 1,200)
- e. That the owners are mere y building the ground to have the ABILITY to one day, if needs require, to expand to a capacity of 5,000? (It would be very thoughtless to not allow for future expansion surely?)
- f. That IF one day in the future the capacity was expanded and that larger crowds DID attend games at Theobalds Lane, that the owners have already approached nearby schools to take possible everflow parking? (even though, looking at points a to d, this is a very unlikely possibility).

### 4 TRAFFIC

With Enfield Football Clubs 1999 plans for Cheshurt Stadium, increased traffic on Theobalds Lane was the main reason for its refusal. I believe this scheme is significantly different...

- a. Enfield's plans would have seen 500+ vehicles arriving on matchdays, all from outside the borough. This scheme is for Cheshurit Football Clubs use and so supporter numbers and matchday traffic would be much the same as today. b. The overwhelming bulk of everyday traffic on Theobalds Lane is through traffic travelling between the Great Cambridge Road and Crossbrook Street, most residents accept this as a feature of the street, as shown in a proposal in the early 2000's to make the western end one-way or to block it completely. When asked, a sizeable majority of residents stated they wished the street to remain exactly as it is. I believe traffic generated by the addition of 158 new homes on the Cheshurit Football Club site will be unnoticeable amongst the existing through traffic, I would also say that the addition of the alf-weather pitches and the increased usage of the clubhouses in the past two years has made an insignificant difference to traffic on Theobalds Lane so would imagine the proposed new community facilities would have an equally negligible effect.
- c. The Entield plans made no mention of improvements to nearby public transport but this plan has indicated improvements to the bus stops at Theoblads Grove (the addition of much needed electronic bus departure boards for instance) and the installation of direction signs for the ground at the Crossbrook Street/Theobalds Lane junction.

The owners have also stated they are keen to see improvements made to the narrow western end of Theobalds Lane and agree with the Council that the current 'priority' signs are an unsatisfactory solution. It would be good to see the Club and the Council use this opportunity to tackle (pardon the pun) this stretch of road and see it improved.

To conclude, I believe that this is a great proposal for not only the Football Glub but for local residents too - a genuine win-win situation - which I hope Broxbourne planning committee support and approve.






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# Good Morning,

As Head Coach at Turnford Gymnastics Club, I'd like to take the opportunity to drop you a mail to show our support for the Cheshunt Sports Village development that is currently seeking planning permission.

Our Club has been in existence for over 40 years and has in the past had gymnasts compete for Great Britain. Now, due to our restricted training facility and hours at Turnford School, we are unable to provide the number and breadth of classes that we would like to. We have a club of 170 members and a waiting list that is consistently around 200. So, without any advertising, we could double the size of our club.

In order to grow and meet our potential, we need a new facility that we could use for more hours, so providing classes for a wider range of the community - pre-school, adults, disability, cheerleading, specialist teenage classes (getting teenagers into/back into sport), street running and holiday camps. We can also seek to achieve a higher standard for our competitive classes. Currently there are examples of children that live in the Borough of Broxbourne competiting for clubs outside the borough or county as a) they can't get a place in our club and b) we aren't able to offer the hours required for regional standard and beyond.

We have tried to re-locate many times previously, but a lack of a suitable facility, or the expense of owning/renting our own facility has meant that his hasn't been achieveable.

On discussing our position with Dean at Cheshunt FC, he has been extremely positive about the club having a suitable facility and becoming a member of the hub that is being proposed at the Theobalds Lane site. It would be fantastic to pull a number of sports and services together in order that we share facilities, ideas, vision and create a fantastic community area for participation and achievement.

With worrying obesity and activity levels in the borough (for all ages), an environment that not only supports our club but others too, has to be a massive opportunity that should be supported and progressed.

I really hope this planning application can be approved to make this happen!





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#### Dear Peter

May I introduce myself I am the owner and Chairman of Thamesmead Town Football Club that play in the Ryman North League as do Cheshunt Football Club. I was made aware of the above project when Dean visited our purpose made stadium a couple of weeks ago to play a league match, and after listening to him describe the ups and downs of such a project it reminds me so much what I was going through when I was the owner of Maidstone United Football Club since the demise of the League Football Club in 1992 until I decided I had taken the Club as far as I could at the beginning of 2010 and allowed my younger colleagues to take the project forward..

Around 2008 I decided that rather than be a Football Club that was always known as the Homeless Club as it lost its ground in 1992 and could only survive by ground sharing with other Clubs, so after many calls and meetings the local Maidstone Council agreed that if I managed to purchase an area of ground in the centre of the Town it would look favourably to issuing planning permission to build a 4500 capacity ground for the Club to return home. So I started the process of discussions with the Landlords who were the Ministry of Defence discussions took over 18 months but in the end I managed to agree a freehold price to purchase the ground, as I was on my own financing the Club I had to find a partner that would assist with the land purchase value of £500,000.00 to this end the Council very kindly lent me 50% repayable in 10 years and I personally found the remainder so I purchased the ground this was the first step on a long journey.

Now we had to work with the Council in detail to ensure that they fully understood what was required so that when we submitted a planning application it would be acceptable to the planning committee, this took another 18 months of discussion and then we submitted a planning application that was accepted unanimously for the following reasons.

We were not trying to build a concrete jungle, we adhered to all the required standards submitted by the officers of the Council, but the basis of my planning thinking was the following

Was there a need for the building of the Stadium

Yes as it would be an asset to the Town and the Council. At this time there were no other centres of sport for the Community to use especially for the age groups 5-12, as all the 3g pitches were built at Technical schools and not available for this age bracket to use at an acceptable price range. At the same time we agreed that the Stadium would not just be used for Football but become a Community Sporting Hub for all to participate, assessable for all local Schools, clubs, community groups, and local businesses. We also agreed a programme of sport with the local Police that would assist tham to keen volithe off the etreete

mem to keep yourns on the streets we had a great response from the Council for this scenario.

Since the old league Club left the Town at its demise in 1992 a small band of supporters around 350 followed the Club on its rise up the pyramid, but we all knew that when we came home the gates would increase at the last Home match the gate was stated as 2850 so our estimates and beliefs were correct. Also who in business want to support a Football Team if they have no Home and we knew that once we returned Home local businesses would want to get involve I am advised that since they moved Home in 2014 76 local businesses have got involved with invoices sales of over £1,000,00.00 has been raised in the last 3 years.45 of these businesses used facilities out of the town but when they got involved with the new facility they moved their requirements to the Town resulting in benefits to other business already situated within the Town so it was a win win situation for all.

Although I left the Club in 2010 my fellow shareholders have now built a purpose made stadium

and are now it level below league football which will bring more good press to the area. Many new Revenue streams have been made that will support the quality and range of opportunities within the football locally in the Maidstone area. 




