

NOTICE OF NON-IMMEDIATE ARTICLE 4 DIRECTION

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 (AS AMENDED)

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) (ENGLAND ORDER 2015) (AS AMENDED)

NOTICE is hereby given that Broxbourne Borough Council has made a non-immediate Article 4 Direction on 15 November 2021, under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (GPDO), as amended.

The Direction applies to development within specified areas, consisting of the following:

• A change of use from commercial, business and services uses to dwelling houses, being development comprised within Class MA of Part 3 of Schedule 2 of the GPDO (or as amended);

The Article 4 Direction removes permitted development rights for these types of development from the date on which it comes into force. Planning permission will therefore be required for the same once the Direction is in force.

The Article 4 Direction applies to the following areas:

- Specified core areas of the Old Pond District centre, Cheshunt
- Specified core areas of Hoddesdon Town Centre, Hoddesdon
- Specified core areas of Waltham Cross Town centre, Waltham Cross
- Cheshunt Business Park, Delamare Road and Fieldings Road, Cheshunt
- Waltham Cross Business Park, Britannia Road to Lea Road, Waltham Cross
- Hoddesdon Business Park, Essex Road, Hoddesdon

The Article 4 Direction will come into force, subject to confirmation by the Council, on 16 November 2022.
