## 1. Welcome & Introductions

# 2. Matters Arising

The youth council went through the minutes from the previous meeting to check accuracy and all members accepted it was correct.

The youth council were shown a video that has been circulating on social media depicting violent incidents accruing at John Warner school. A discussion took place about bullying, fighting and how this is addressed within schools in Broxbourne Borough. The youth council also explored if the correct school policies are in place to swiftly deal with a changing culture within educational settings.

## 3. Lowewood Museum with Naomi

Ethan informed the youth council that a newly appointed Community Officer for Lowewood Museum has offered members the opportunity to contribute towards a plan for a new community hub in the Museum. Part of the funding comes from the National Lottery Community fund. This community hub initiative is run by the new Trust setup after the withdrawal of Broxbourne Council from Lowewood Museum. The youth council have decided they would at least like to have a one-off external meeting at the Lowewood Museum after May 2022 to start building a working relationship.
