2. Cabinet Member for Transport

After a short speech by nominees, the vote for the Cabinet Member for Transport was held. Gabbie was voted into this position by fellow council members.

3. Feeling Good Week

At previous meetings, Linton made council members aware of the fact that Feel Good Week is in February. This will allow us to apply for £500 of funding to run a project to boost young people's wellbeing during the week. In this meeting, we discussed ideas for our project and application.

The two following ideas were put forward;
