I really thought that this had been closed and that we would not face further attempts from Countryside Properties regarding this development.

It is outrageous that the Council would entertain any further development within the Goffs Oak area. The whole area is being catastrophically over-developed and spoilt and I am writing to object firmly to any progression of the proposed development of the Fairmead site. The Council voted against this development and that should prevail with no further attempts to develop going forward.

Most of the Goffs Oak residents are horrified at the amount of development in the Goffs Oak area- the area has been totally spoilt. There is not the infrastructure in place to cope with the number of new houses.
