Objection to proposals:

I write on behalf of myself and my Husband regarding the above-named proposed development and we wish to oppose this.

We would be extremely devastated to see the beautiful woodland area in question pulled down in place for yet more housing. We can hear the birds and wildlife enjoying this small patch of woodland and it would be so harmful to have this removed and those natural habitats destroyed. There is so few areas like this remaining in the Goffs Oak area, all of which are being turned into housing developments, which we feel this small village just cannot cope with.

The affect these building developments (such as this one) are having on the local roads is unbearable. Constant road closures and temporary traffic lights to allow works to take place and delivery trucks to offload materials. A simple drive from the Goffs Oak village down to Cuffley village should take a couple of minutes, but we have been subjected to traffic queues of well over 20 minutes on many occasions due to works such as this taking place.
