As a resident for the last 17 years moving here from Enfield wanting a better environment and schools for our daughter, I am appalled that the amount of development is taking place within Goffs Oak.

The infrastructure will not support this, we are unable to get an appointment within a reasonable time scale with doctors as it is. Cuffley Hill is already to its full capacity during school run times and and around working hours. If there is a problem on the M25 everything comes through Cheshunt/Goffs Oak/Cuffley and it comes to a standstill. I can sometimes take me over half an hour to get from my house to the other end of Cuffley village.

We have had to put up with total disruption for the last two years from the building of Edwards Gate (old C. Edwards Site) and understand that this is not due to be completed until May 2022 so to have another site start up along the road is unacceptable.
