BOROUGH OF BROXBOURNE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH OF BROXBOURNE (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES) ORDER NO 2. 2023

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BROXBOURNE, pursuant to arrangements made with the Hertfordshire County Council under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Authorities (Arrangements for the Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000, and in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter called "the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

1(1) In this Order

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.

"Disabled Person's Vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the 1984 Act

"Driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a Parking Place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the Parking Place

"Parking Place" means any part of a road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place

"Penalty Charge" shall have the same meaning as a charge set by the Council in accordance with The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022 and the provisions of Part 6 and Schedule 9 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"Penalty Charge Notice" shall mean a notice issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in accordance with The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022 and the provisions of Part 6 and Schedule 9 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

- (2) For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position if:
 - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that the serial number and the date of expiry of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; or
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the serial number and the date of expiry of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment
- 4(1) Those parts of the roads specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 and shown for identification purposes only in the plan in the Schedule to this Order are authorised

to be used in a position specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule 1 and subject to the following provisions of this Order, as Parking Places at any time for Disabled Person's Vehicles which display in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge.

- (2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council, for preventing obstruction of the roads, by order, or by notice on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination, or when the roads are thronged or liable to be obstructed, to close the Parking Place.
- Where in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order a Parking Place is described as available for a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge, the Driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that Parking Place unless it is:
 - (a) a Disabled Person's Vehicle on which is displayed in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge, and
 - (b) wholly within the limits of the Parking Place.
- 6 A Driver of a vehicle shall not use a Parking Place:-
 - (a) so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance;
 - (b) when for preventing obstruction of the road the Council shall by order or by notice made on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination or when the roads are thronged or liable to be obstructed have closed that Parking Place and exhibited notice of such closing on or near the Parking Place.
- The Driver of a motor vehicle using a Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in a position in the Parking Place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.
- No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a Parking Place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or service.
- Subject to the provision hereto, when a vehicle is left in a Parking Place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that Parking Place provided that when a vehicle is waiting in a Parking Place in contravention of the provisions of Articles 4 and 5 of this Order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.
- Any person removing a vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Article 9 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or moving the vehicle in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position, as the case may be.
- When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a Parking Place by virtue of Article 9 of this Order, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for safe custody of the vehicle.
- 12(1) If a vehicle (other than a vehicle otherwise exempted by this Order) is left in contravention of any Article or provision of this Order, a penalty charge shall be payable.

- (2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may be issued in accordance with the Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022.
- (3) The penalty charge must be paid to Broxbourne Borough Council in accordance with the instructions and within the time limits specified on the penalty charge notice.
- 13 The lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order are no longer authorised for the sole parking of disabled persons vehicles.
- The provisions of The Borough of Broxbourne (Control of Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2013 ("the 2013 Order") are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order.
- Paragraph 3 of schedule 1 of the Borough of Broxbourne (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order No.2 2014 is revoked.
- Paragraph 15 of schedule 1 of the Borough of Broxbourne (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2016 is revoked.

- Paragraph 6, 7 & 24 of schedule 1 of the Borough of Broxbourne (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2017 is revoked.
- 19 Paragraph 17 of schedule 1 of the Borough of Broxbourne (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order No.2 2017 is revoked.
- 20 Paragraph 8 of schedule 1 of the Borough of Broxbourne (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2018 is revoked.
- 21 Paragraph 5 & 23 of schedule 1 of the Borough of Broxbourne (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order No.2 2019 is revoked.
- This Order shall come into operation on **DD Month YYYY** and may be cited as the Borough of Broxbourne (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) Order No.2 2023.

ST AUGUSTINES DRIVE, BROXBOURNE. West side from a point 3.0 metres north of a point in line with the southern flank wall of No.17 St Augustines Drive, southward for a distance of 6.0 metres.

GALLOWAY CLOSE, BROXBOURNE. East side from a point in line with the northern flank wall of No. 3 Shire Close, northwards for a distance of 2.85 metres.

BERNERS WAY, BROXBOURNE. East side from a point in line with the northern flank wall of No.70, North – East for a distance of 6.0 metres.

LAWRENCE GARDENS, CHESHUNT. South side of access road servicing Nos. 1 to 14; Nos 37 to 42; Nos 54 to 59; and Nos 63 to 72, from a point in line 6.5 metres west of the easternmost flank wall of No.9 westwards for a distance of 2.5 metres.

CAMBRIDGE CLOSE, CHESHUNT. East side from a point in line with the boundary between Nos. 8/10 Northwards for a distance of 6.0 metres.

ELDERBECK CLOSE, CHESHUNT. North side from a point 34.0 metres east of a point in line with the western flank wall of Nos.67 – 69 Elderbeck Close, eastwards for a distance of 2.4 metres.

DOWNFIELD ROAD (Wakefield Walk), CHESHUNT South side from a point 13.2 metres east of a point in line with the western flank wall of No.5 Wakefield Walk, eastwards for a distance of 5.5 metres.

ELDERBECK CLOSE, CHESHUNT. West side from a point 13.8 metres north of a point in line with the northern flank wall of No.66 Elderbek Close, northwards for a distance of 2.6 metres.

ELDERBECK CLOSE, CHESHUNT. North side from a point 16.6metres west of a point in line with the eastern flank wall of Nos.80-82 Elderbeck Close, westwards for a distance of 2.4 metres.

ELDERBECK CLOSE, CHESHUNT. East side from a point 6.5 metres north of a point in line with the northern flank wall of No. 66 Elderbeck Close, northward for a distance of 5.0 metres.

WINDMILL LANE, CHESHUNT. North side from a point 0.3 metres west of a point in line with the boundary between Nos.139 & 141 Windmill Lane, eastwards for a distance of 6.0 metres.

SWANFIELD ROAD, WALTHAM CROSS. North side from a point in line with the boundary between Nos.29 & 31 Swanfield Road, westwards for a distance of 5.5 metres.
