Faye and Matt from Herts Sport & Physical Activity Partnership run a programme called Herts Summer Parks, a programme designed to provide free activities and food for 12 – 16-year-olds on benefit-related free school meals during the summer holidays.

- Don't give in to pressure
- If you don't smoke, don't vape
