

Site inspection 28/1/83 Church Lane.

Infilling steady but according to Mr Cooke business very quiet. final layer of waste being tipped and covered with soil on western half of main excavation.

Although the infilling has formed a dome recent heavy rain has caused settlement. This has been made good by another layer of fill where necessary.

Mr Cooke advised to tidy up western part of site to give good impression of how site will ~~look~~ look when completed.

Mr Edwards to arrange for draglines to be either moved to vicinity of Mr Cooke's site but or cut up by scrap dealer. Processors plants are to be cut up for scrap and removed.

Mr Edwards site hut and stove north of access road to be removed. The soil around the trees in tree belt to be levelled by Mr Cooke.

Mr Cooke pointed out that he did not move onto the site until 28/9/81.
