Thank you for your letter of 29th March 2010. Please find copy letter dated 1st December 2009, sent to Mr Williams the field force supervisor for Borough of Broxbourne, Churchgate, Cheshunt. The letter is self explanatory. As a result of Mr Williams letter, a meeting was set up for an inspection of the land in question, all remaining items stored on land are to be used in the construction of livestock sheds.

We presently have an ongoing boundary dispute with our neighbour Mr Mc Kinley, who is an arrogant trouble maker, so we presume you have also received a complaint of a similar nature, to that sent to Broxbourne Council.

It would appear Mr McKinley is held bent on using Rate payer's money, by once again using the Council to fight his corner, to boost his case concerning the boundary dispute. Most of the mess, that has now been cleared, was made by workmen working for Mr McKinley, to help substantiate his complaint

We have recently undertaken repairs to the road. In the general course of events we strive to keep the land tidy, so it is suitable for use with livestock. This has not been possible for the last few months, due to interference and the addition of rubbish being thrown around without care or consideration, by the workmen employed by Mr McKinley, once again this was done deliberately to boost his case.
