

ENVIRONMENT ACT 1995: REVIEW OF MINERAL SITES

NOTICE UNDER PARAGRAPHS 3 AND 8 OF SCHEDULE 13 TO THE ENVIRONMENT ACT 1995

I give notice that:

Hertfordshire County Council have prepared a list of mineral sites in their area.

A site is only included in the list if :


- a) the land has the benefit of a planning permission or permissions (other than an "old mining permission", as defined in section 22 of the Planning and Compensation Act 1991, or permission granted by General Development Order) for development consisting of the winning and working of minerals or involving the depositing of mineral waste; and,
- b) the permission(s) relating to the greater part of that land were granted before 22 February 1982. The list classifies each such site as either "dormant", "active Phase I", or "active Phase II".

A copy of the list may be inspected at Borough of Broxbourne, Borough Offices, Bishops' College, Churchgate, Cheshunt, Waltham Cross, Hertfordshire and at Restoration, Minerals and Waste Planning Unit, Environment Department, Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford SG13 8DN between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm (Monday to Friday).

The land at Church Lane, Wormley has been classified as a dormant site.

AS THIS SITE HAS BEEN CLASSIFIED AS "DORMANT", NO DEVELOPMENT CONSISTING OF THE WINNING AND WORKING OF MINERALS OR INVOLVING THE DEPOSITING OF MINERAL WASTE MAY LAWFULLY BE CARRIED OUT UNTIL NEW PLANNING CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN SUBMITTED TO, AND APPROVED BY, THE COUNTY COUNCIL.
