The report overleaf sets out the decision to be taken, the reasons for the decision, and the details of alternative options, if any, considered and rejected.

Officer decisions are available for public inspection, both at the Borough Offices and on the Council's website. Officer decisions are kept for a period of six years at the Borough Offices and for six months on the website after the decision is made. Background papers are available for four years.

RECOMMENDED that: a virement of £5,450 from the 2020/21 Revenue Contingency Budget to fund the replacement of external front bi-parting doors at the Cheshunt Park Golf Centre be approved

Purpose

To request a virement of £5,450 from the 2020/21 Revenue Contingency Budget to allow for the replacement of the front bi-parting doors at Cheshunt Park Golf Centre (CPGC) as they do not meet British standards.

The Project

A recent service of the doors at CPGC noted that the front automatic bi-parting doors no longer meets 16005 standards. It is proposed that these doors be replaced as they have reached the end of their life and are unsafe.

Financial, Legal and Risk Management Implications

The following quotes have been received:

- Doorwise £5,450
- SRL Ltd £5,830
- Reactive doors £6,130

Three quotes have been received as detailed above. It is recommended that Doorwise be used to supply the front doors at CPGC as it has provided the best value quote.

Alternative Options Considered and Rejected

Doing nothing was considered and rejected as it was noted that the Council would be liable for any accidents that resulted from the current front doors. The doors have now reached the end of the life and are considered unsafe.

Contribution to the Council's Objectives

14.2 Manage the Council's assets efficiently.

Conclusion

Approval is given for a virement from the 2020/21 Revenue Contingency Budget of £5,450 to fund the replacement of the bi-parting doors at CPGC. This will leave a balance of £194,550 in this budget.
