

PRIVACY NOTICE – PLANNING ENFORCEMENT

Why are we processing your information

We are processing your information for the purposes of providing you with a service in respect of alleged breaches of planning control. In order to ensure effective enforcement to maintain public confidence in planning system we process personal information as part of the investigation into alleged breaches of planning control.

Purpose of processing

Your information will be used by the Borough of Broxbourne for the purpose of investigating alleged breaches of planning control. This is to ensure that all breaches are investigated, and resolution is reached by negotiation, wherever possible, prior to formal enforcement action.

Your information could also be used to contact the complainant and person(s) with interest in the land for the following reasons:-

- 1. To request more information about alleged breach
- 2. To visit relevant site and arrange meetings
- 3. Provide advice regarding the breach and investigation
- 4. To serve formal enforcement notices
