TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER,
1950.

WHEREAS the County Council of the Administrative County of Hertford (hereinafter called "the County Council") are the Local Planning Authority for the Administrative County of Hertford by virtue of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947.

AND WHEREAS the County Council are satisfied that certain development of the classes specified in the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950 should not be carried out in certain areas within the Administrative County of Hertford unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf.

NOW THEREFORE the County Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf Direct that permission granted by Article 3 of that Order shall not apply to any development specified in the First Schedule hereto in the areas specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

THIS Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire County Council (Town and Country Planning) (Direction restricting permitted development) No. 1 Order, 1951."

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Development as specified in paragraph 1 of Class VI of the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950 for the purposes of market gardens and nursery grounds.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

The Urban Districts of Hoddesdon and Cheshunt.

In the Rural District of Ware
the Parishes of Stanstead St. Margarets
and Great Amwell.

In the Rural District of Hatfield
the Parish of Northaw.

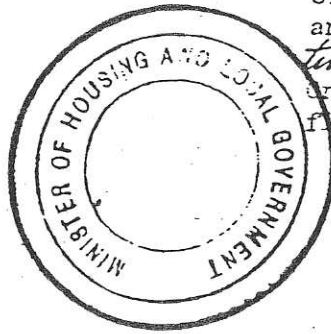

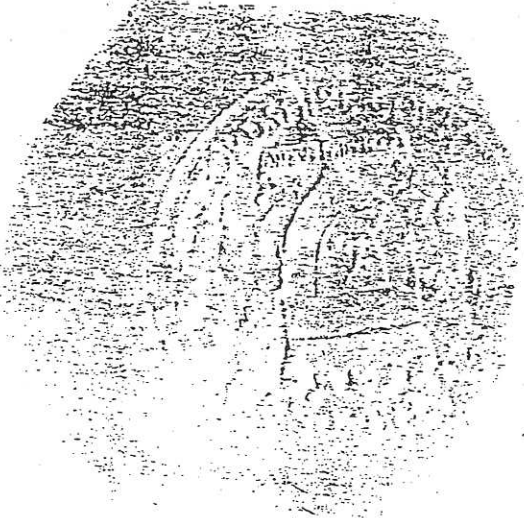
