

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Timescale - How long will the work go on for?

The works started on 7th January 2019 and are expected to finish this summer.

2. How much is it going to cost?

The total estimated cost of the scheme is £1.36million. Of this £678,173 will be funded by the Hertfordshire Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP). The balance will be funded by the Council. The project is part of a wider regeneration plan for Waltham Cross.

3. What disruptions are expected and will I still be able to get to the shops?

Although some element of disruption is expected, the Council's contractors will keep this to a minimum, and businesses are expected to trade as usual.

4. Will shops in the town centre need to close?

No. The contractor will be in contact with the affected shopkeepers on a regular basis to make sure that access to all shops is managed and maintained at all times, as far as is possible, so that it will not be necessary of any shops to close as a result of the works.

5. Will parking be restricted?

There will be a loss of some parking spaces in the High Street car park. However the car park will remain open. The car parks in Eleanor Cross Road and the Waltham Cross playing fields will be unaffected.
