

NOTICE TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SCRUTINY COMMITTEE OF A GENERAL EXCEPTION TO THE PUBLICATION OF THE INTENTION TO MAKE A KEY DECISION¹

AND

NOTICE SETTING OUT REASONS WHY PUBLICITY REQUIREMENTS ARE IMPRACTICABLE²

Where a decision maker intends to make a key decision, that decision must not be made until at least 28 clear days public notice has been given³

Where the publication of the intention to make a key decision is impracticable, that decision may only be made where the Chairman of the relevant Overview and Scrutiny Committee(s) has been informed of the matter about which the decision is to be made, notice to the Chairman has been made available for public inspection at the Council offices and published on the Council's website, and after five clear days have elapsed following the day on which notice to the Chairman was made publicly available.⁴

This notice is to inform the Chairman of Scrutiny Committee that it has been impracticable to give 28 clear days public notice of the item(s) set out below for the reasons set out below and that it is intended that the key decision(s) will be made on the date specified below.

Notice is also given to members of the public that the reasons why compliance with the requirements for publicity in connection with key decisions are impracticable are set out below.

Decisions listed below will, unless otherwise indicated, be made by the Cabinet.

Documents listed in column four will be available to view five days prior to the relevant meeting from the Council's website www.broxbourne.gov.uk or on request from the Council's offices: Borough Offices, Bishops' College, Churchgate, Cheshunt, Herts EN8 9XG, unless exempt from publication.

Future Funding for Community Safety Resources	Cabinet, 9 Sept. 2014	The Council has an agreement for the provision of community safety resources which expires on 31 March 2015. Should the Council wish to amend this agreement, six months' notice is required (i.e by 30 September 2014). Possible amendments to this agreement have only very recently been proposed.	Report from the Community Safety Manager setting out the possible options. Report is to be exempt from publication.
