Purpose

To determine a late application from the East Herts District Scouts for facility subsidy for 2018/19 that did not go in front of the Grants Panel at its meeting on Tuesday 6 February 2018.

East Herts District Scouts

The East Herts District Scouts are requesting 100% facility subsidy for the 2018/19 financial year for the use of Deaconsfield for their annual fete (£250) and the Laura Trott Leisure Centre swimming pool for their annual swimming gala (£259.40). The Council has awarded this subsidy regularly since 2008.

The financial accounts for the year ending 31st December 2016 show that this organisation had a net income of £8,494 with a closing cash balance of £72,558.

The cost of the requested awards can be met from existing budget estimates. As a discretionary scheme there are no legal implications arising. The awards should be determined in accordance with the determination criteria set out in the Community Grant Scheme Policy.
