Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004

The Town and County Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

In accordance with the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and the Town and County Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that the Statement of Community Involvement was approved by the Broxbourne Borough Council Executive on 12th May 2016 for adoption.

The Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) sets out how and when the community will be involved in the preparation of a Local Plan and other planning documents and how they will be consulted on planning applications in Broxbourne.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event no later than three months after the date on which the SCI was adopted.

Those who submitted comments to the consultation and those requesting to be informed of adoption have been notified accordingly.

The modifications made to the document pursuant to the representations received and other relevant matters are within the Consultation Statement.
